- There will be a winner chosen for each theme for entries in each category. Therefore each category will have three opportunities to win. Nine winners in total.
- By submitting the photograph, you confirm that you are the copyright holder and creator of that image and that you will be responsible for any claims by any third party.
- Copyright will remain with the photographer. However, by entering this competition, the photographer agrees to London Wildlife Trust and Walthamstow Wetlands using the image for exhibitions, publications or promotional uses. London Wildlife Trust may offer members of the public a chance to own copies of the shortlisted photos through cost-effective sales or donations, full proceeds of which will go towards the conservation work of London Wildlife Trust and operations at Walthamstow Wetlands.
- For the categories, 'Young Photographer – Under 16s' and 'Amateur Photographer' images should be landscape and must be 300dpi, 12"x8" (A4) jpg images. Images not submitted at this size cannot be considered. For the category 'Smartphone Photographer' images can be any size.
- Images submitted via social media (Twitter, Facebook, Instagram) must use the #E17Wetlandsphotocomp. By entering via social media using the aforementioned hashtag, you will automatically be entering the smartphone photographer category. Alongside your image and hashtag, please also make clear which theme you are entering.
- For the categories, 'Young Photographer – Under 16s' and 'Amateur Photographer' entries can be received electronically through a file transfer website such as <https://wettransfer.com/>. Along with your transfer link, please make clear which category and which theme you are entering. The transfer link should be sent with your name and contact details to Wetlandscomp@wildlondon.org.uk
- Images must have been taken in Walthamstow Wetlands
- Permission and written consent must be obtained from any recognisable person featured in the photograph (consent to be included with the entry when sending electronically)
- A maximum of three images per person can be entered into the competition.
- Entries close on Sunday 27th January 2019
- Shortlisted candidates will be notified (only) on 29th January 2019
- Winners announced at the World Wetlands weekend event on 3rd February and on social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram).
- Winners of each theme in each entry category will be displayed at Walthamstow Wetlands for members for 6 weeks from the 3rd February.
- Judges will be looking for 'natural' photos so entrants should avoid too much post-processing and the use of post-camera effects.
- The Judges' decision is final
